Statement

On the invitation of the Government for bilateral talks

Date: 9 September 2017

With regard to the official invitation extended to the Restoration Council of Shan State by the Government's National Reconciliation and Peace Centre (NRPC) to meet with the State Counselor, RCSS issues the following statement.

1. Since RCSS assumes the invitation of the Government to be a trust enhancing act between the two parties, the Chairman of the RCSS, Gen. Yawd Serk, will lead a delegation to Nay Pyi Taw to hold talks with the State Counselor, military leaders and Union Ministers, and will continue to Yangon to meet with political parties and foreign diplomats.
2. Matters concerning the implementation of the Peace Process, political issues and local public development will also be discussed with concerned leaders during this mission.
3. It is believed that this journey of the RCSS Delegation to Nay Pyi Taw—Yangon will be of great support for the building of trust, the implementation of the peace process and the building of Federal Union.
